## **11. ELECTRONIC LICENSING**

### **EXPLANATION:**

The department currently administers a wide variety of licenses and registrations. The department also provides a wide variety of inspection, testing and certification services on a user fee basis. The department would like to give license applicants and service requesters the opportunity to apply and pay electronically, rather than by conventional "hard copy" methods. In many cases, electronic filing and payment may be more efficient for applicants and the department. This legislation authorizes the department to accept electronic applications and payments, and charge a fee for electronic processing costs.

### **STATUTORY LANGUAGE:**

**SECTION \_\_\_\_ . 93.06(1n) of the statutes is created to read:**

**93.06(1n) The department may do any of the following by electronic means and may charge, in addition to any other fee, a fee to cover the department's electronic processing costs:**

- (a) Accept and process applications and payments for licenses, permits, registrations and certificates.**
- (b) Accept and process requests and payments for any goods and services which the department is authorized to provide.**
