12. FEDERAL DAIRY REFORM

EXPLANATION:

The 1997-99 biennial budget act (1997 Wis. Act 27) authorized the department to promote reform of federal dairy policy that adversely affects Wisconsin farmers, and appropriated \$50,000 in each year of the biennium for that purpose. (See ss. 20.115(4)(cd) and 93.06(12), Stats.) The authorization and appropriation is scheduled to "sunset" at the end of the 1997-99 biennium. (See 1997 Wis. Act 27, sections 173b, 2493(b) and 9404(2x).) This legislation extends the "sunset" date to July 1, 2001, in a way that allows the department to retain the 1997-99 appropriation as part of the department's budget "base" for 1999-2001.

NONSTATUTORY PROVISIONS:

SECTION ____. Section 9404(2x) of 1997 Wis. Act 27 (effective dates; agriculture, trade and consumer protection) is amended to read:

SECTION 9404(2x) FEDERAL DAIRY POLICY REFORM. The repeal of sections 20.115(4)(cd) and 93.06(12) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 1999 2001.
