14. RABIES CONTROL; TRAINING COSTS

EXPLANATION:

The department currently approves local rabies control programs, and provides training to individuals performing rabies examinations under those programs, pursuant to s. 95.21, Stats. This legislation clarifies that the department may charge a fee to cover its training costs.

STATUTORY LANGUAGE:

SECTION ____. 95.21(9)(c) of the statutes is created to read:

95.21(9)(c) The department may provide training to persons who administer local rabies control programs or conduct rabies examinations under those programs. The department may charge a fee to cover the cost of training. The department shall deposit all fees under this paragraph to the appropriation under s. 20.115(2)(j).

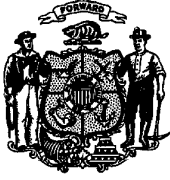
