**15. AGRICULTURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT; GRANT RECEIPTS AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS**

**EXPLANATION:**

DATCP currently administers agricultural resource management programs under chs. 88 and 91 to 94, Stats. This includes gypsy moth control and other plant protection programs under ch. 94, Stats. At the national level, various states are working with the U.S. Department of Agriculture to create a gypsy moth "slow-the-spread" program that would facilitate a cooperative regional approach to gypsy moth control. USDA would initially fund the program, which could eventually draw contributions from industry and other sources. Funds would be paid to a nonprofit corporation or foundation which would, in turn, disburse funds to participating states. According to USDA, this mechanism would provide greater funding flexibility, and avoid constraints that hamper traditional federal grant programs. Wisconsin could receive \$500,000 to \$2 million annually under this program.

DATCP proposes to create a "gifts and grants" appropriation for agricultural resource management. This would allow DATCP to accept "gifts and grants" from outside sources (such as the proposed "slow the spread" foundation) to fund agricultural resource management activities, subject to limitations imposed by the state ethics code and lobbying laws.

DATCP also proposes legislation that would authorize DATCP to enter into cooperative arrangements with corporations, associations, foundations, cooperatives and individuals for the purpose of administering plant protection programs under ch. 94, Stats. This would allow DATCP to participate in the proposed "slow-the-spread" program.

20.115(8)(g) Gifts and grants. Except as provided in sub. (2)(gb), ~~or (3)(ga) or (7)(gb)~~, all moneys received from gifts and grants to carry out the purposes for which made.

93.06(11)(c) Enter into cooperative agreements with corporations, associations, foundations, cooperatives and individuals for the purpose of carrying out plant protection activities under ch. 94, Stats.

This bill authorizes the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection (DATCP) ✓ to enter into cooperative agreements to carry out plant protection activities. The bill also creates an appropriation to DATCP for gifts and grants for agricultural resource management purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

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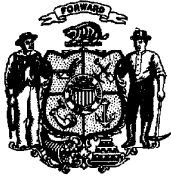
