Issue/Topic: CAPTIVE WILDLIFE IMPLEMENTATION

Proposed Change: This request is to raise the fees for all captive wildlife licenses to more accurately reflect the actual costs of issuing those licenses.

Request: The fees need to be raised for the following captive wildlife licenses.

- OK 29.563(9)(a) 2 29.092(9)(a) Pheasant and quail farm license. Increase fee from \$20.00 to \$100.00 ✓
- OK 3. 2.29.092(9)(b) Game bird and animal farm license. Increase fee from \$10.00 to \$25.00 ✓
- OK 4. 29.092(9)(c) Fur animal farm license. Increase fee from \$10.00 to \$25.00 *already 25*
- OK 5. 29.092(9)(d) Deer farm license. Increase fee from \$25.00 to \$100.00 ✓
- ? (9)(b) 29.092(9)(i) Bird and game farms; late fee. Increase from \$10.00 to \$20.00
- OK (9)(a) 10 29.092(9)(j) Wildlife exhibit license. Increase from \$10.00 to \$25.00 ✓

29.092(9) (k) Surcharges fees for specific license activities

are there any more game farm licenses?

1. The fee for a game farm license authorizing the possession of a bear shall include a surcharge of \$25.00
2. The fee for a game bird and animal farm license for a game farm that sells the opportunity to hunt game birds shall include a surcharge of \$75.00 *(6)(a)*
3. The fee for a wildlife exhibit license authorizing the exhibition of a bear or cougar shall include a surcharge of \$25.00
4. The fee for a game farm license, for a game farm that grossed \$10,000 or more in the sale of live wild animals in the prior year shall include a surcharge of \$75.00
5. The fee for a game farm license authorizing the hunting of grouse shall include a surcharge of \$25.00
6. The fee for a dog training permit issued under NR 17.02 authorizing the possession of a bear shall include a surcharge of \$25.00 *no underlying permit fee in statute?*

where should this go? → 29.184(3)(b)3.

Explanatory Note: Currently, the difference between the fees collected and the costs incurred by the Department for issuing the licenses is supported by other hunting and fishing license revenue. These fees were part of broader legislation affecting captive wildlife that stalled in the Legislature over other issues, but the fees as modified were not a major issue with the industry.

Desired Effective Date: July 1, 1999, or the effective date of the biennial budget.

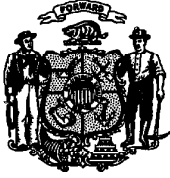
