Proposed Change: This request would allow the Department to authorize an issuance fee to vendors for selling bonus deer permits. The proposed change would be to include "Bonus deer hunting permits" from s. 29.1075 as an item authorized for an issuance fee in s. 29.092 (15). 75¢

Explanatory Note: This change is needed to implement the new on-line licensing system being developed by the Department.

NATURAL RESOURCES

FISH, GAME AND WILDLIFE

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) may issue bonus deer hunting permits to state residents and nonresidents who hold licenses that authorize the hunting of deer if DNR determines that the size or characteristics of the state's deer population require the hunting of additional or special types of deer. This permit allows the holder to kill an additional deer of the sex or type authorized by DNR. Under current law, an applicant for this permit must pay a fee for the permit unless the applicant meets certain qualifications as a state resident farm owner.

Also, under current law, DNR or its agents collect an issuing fee for most fish and game licenses and all fish and game stamps. This bill requires that if a person must pay a permit fee for a bonus deer hunting permit, he or she must also pay an issuing fee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
