#### Statutory Language Proposals

Subprograms: DIVISIONWIDE

Issue/Topic: DIVISION OF LAND ENDOWMENT FUND

<u>Proposed Change</u>: Create an appropriation that would allow the Department to establish an endowment fund and receive voluntary, tax-deductible contributions from donors to provide funding for preserving, managing, and maintaining conservation lands. Also, create an appropriation that would allow for expenditures for this purpose from the interest received on the endowment fund.

Explanatory Note: Wisconsin citizens, businesses and organizations are willing to donate funds to preserve, manage and maintain conservation lands and programs. Evidence of this generosity is found within state government (e.g., the Endangered Resources Tax Checkoff) and throughout the nonprofit sector. This fund would allow the Department to receive funds, property, estates, stocks or other items to create principal to remain in perpetuity. The language would specify that all gifts to the fund would be tax deductible. The interest generated from the fund would be used to provide for acquisition, operation or maintenance of Department properties.

Desired Effective Date: July 1, 1999 or the effective date of the 1999-01 Biennial Budget.
