Issue/Topic: Funding of Non-structural alternatives to dam repair

<u>Proposed Change</u>: The Department proposes to amend Wis. Stat. s. 31.385 to allow the Department to fund non-structural alternatives to dam repair and reconstruction.

Explanatory Note: This proposal would amend Wis. Stat. s. 31.385 to indicate that funding would be allowed for actions that reduce the hazard classification of a dam. In certain situations, a dam owner could reduce the extent and/or cost of dam repair if the hazard rating for the dam were lowered. The purchase and removal of structures below the dam could result in reduced spillway design requirements and therefore lower project costs. Where it can be demonstrated that a non-structural alternative is the best option for making the dam comply with applicable codes and reducing long-term hazards, the cost of the acquisition and removal of at-risk structures should be allowed under the Ch. 31 dam maintenance, repair, modification, abandonment and removal aid program.
