1999-2001 Statutory Language Proposals

Division: Customer Assistance and External Relations

Bureau: Customer Service and Licensing

Issue/Topic: Handling Fee for Reserved Backtag Numbers

Proposed Change: Create an annual \$5 handling fee for hunters who wish to reserve a deer backtag number so they retain the same number from year-to-year. The total \$5 fee consists of a \$0.50 issuance fee for the ALIS license agent and \$4.50 fee for the reserved number. Revenue from the fee will be deposited in the Conservation Fund.

Explanatory Note: These low numbers are highly sought after. At the present time, only the first 2,000 backtag numbers for sports and conservation patron licenses are reserved, and all of the requests are processed manually in Madison either in person or via a mail renewal. The new automated license issuance system (ALIS) will not only support this practice but permit the number of reserved numbers to be significantly expanded (i.e. up to the first 5,000 numbers). A handling fee is proposed to cover the administrative costs of expanding this service. In addition, costs for this service should not be covered from general license sales but rather by the person who is receiving the service.
