**1999-2001 Statutory Language Proposals**

Division: Customer Assistance and External Relations

Bureau: Customer Service and Licensing

Issue/Topic: Annual Renewal Cycle for Nonresident Snowmobile Sticker

Proposed Change: The 1997-99 biennial budget created the nonresident snowmobile sticker effective May 1, 1998. The sticker is required under s. 350.12(3j) Wis stats and is valid for one year (s. 350.12(3j)(b)). As a result, the annual period for a nonresident snowmobile sticker is May 1 through April 30. However, all other annual licenses and permits issued by the Department are valid April 1 through March 31. The Department proposes that the annual cycle for the nonresident snowmobile sticker be modified to coincide with the standard period of April 1 through March 31.

Explanatory Note: This change will simplify administrative procedures and be less confusing to DNR customers.

Desired Effective Date: Upon passage of the budget.
