Under current law, (DNR) administers the registration system for all-terrain vehicles, boats and snowmobiles. This bill gives DNR the authority to appoint agents, who may be county clerks or other persons not employed by DNR, to renew, but not issue, noncommercial registration certificates for all-terrain vehicles, certificates of numbers and of registration for boats and noncommercial registration certificates for snowmobiles that are not antiques and that are not used exclusively on private property. Under current law, DNR has this appointment authority for issuing fish and game approvals.

Mary Gibson-Glass forwarded us copies of two pieces of draft statutory language for the 99-01 biennial budget. One is LRB-0217/1dn, the \$3 counter fee for instant registration renewal for boats, snowmobiles and ATVs. The other is LRB-0221/P1dn, giving DNR the authority to appoint agents to renew registration for boat, snowmobile and ATV under ALIS.

These drafts have been reviewed by staff in the Bureau of Legal Services, Customer Service and Licensing, and Law Enforcement. I would like to highlight the key changes we are requesting. I will also attach an edited draft of LRB 0221/P1dn.

Changes to LRB-0221/P1dn; BATS Registration Renewal Under ALIS

1. You pointed out the need to distinguish between private, public and commercial registration. We have reviewed the language and made changes accordingly. In 23.33(2)(1), we deleted "or for private use" because there is no expiration on private use ATV registrations. We added "commercial certificate" to 23.33(2)(i) and to 350.12(3h).
2. We are comfortable with the language that gives appointed agents the ability to collect voluntary contributions for lakes research.
3. It would appear that we also need to amend s. 350.12(5)(b) as follows:

The following is an additional statutory language proposal for the FY1999-2001 biennial budget. I have indicated my priority ranking below.

The intent of this request is to allow the Department of Natural Resources to appoint agents to complete original and duplicate registrations of snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles. In addition, create a \$3 fee (\$1 to be retained by the agent, \$2 to be remitted to DNR) to cover transaction costs.

- Agents would collect all paperwork and registration fees and send them to DNR, who would issue the actual registration certificates. The agent would provide the owner with a validated receipt to be used until the actual registration certificate.
- Agents would be required to collect any sales tax due and remit it to DNR with the registration fees. Agents would also be subject to the Department of Revenue approved methods. *remit directly to DNR*
- After completing a sale, snowmobile dealers must collect all paperwork and registration fees and send them to DNR under current law (s. 350.125(1)(a)). Current law does not allow the dealer to charge an additional fee for this service. I do not yet know if this requested language will allow the dealer to charge the \$3 fee. *Dealer to charge \$3, \$2 remitt to DNR*

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) administers the registration system to issue certificates for all-terrain vehicles, boats and snowmobiles. This bill authorizes DNR to establish an additional fee for expedited service that may be charged to cover the increased costs that are associated with renewing certain certificates for persons who wish to renew the certificates immediately and in person. The certificates to which this authority applies are registration certificates for all-terrain vehicles except those registered for use exclusively on private property, certificates of number and of registration for boats and registration certificates for snowmobiles that are not antiques or that are not used exclusively on private property. If DNR decides to charge this additional fee, the fee must be \$3.



The bill also authorizes DNR to appoint these types of agents to renew certain all-terrain vehicle and snowmobile certificates and all certificates of number and of registration for boats. The bill also authorizes DNR to establish an expedited service for these renewals, which may be used by the agents or by DNR directly.
