Issue/Topic: GRAVEL PIT RECLAMATION ON DNR PROPERTIES - PROGRAM REVENUE APPROPRIATION

Proposed Change: Create a program revenue appropriation in s. 20.370 (1) to deposit fees for permits for gravel mining on DNR properties to be used to reclaim abandoned gravel mines on DNR properties.

Explanatory Note: New regulations pertaining to nonmetallic mining will require the Department to reclaim abandoned gravel pits. Currently, fees collected for permits for gravel mining on Department lands are deposited in the Conservation Fund. This change would allow the Department to use the revenue from these fees to pay for the costs of reclaiming the gravel pits.

Desired Effective Date: July 1, 1999 or the effective date of the 1999-01 Biennial Budget
