This section would revise Section 285.60, Wis. Stats. either as (1)(a)3. or

(3a) or (8).

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION PERMITS. The department may, by rule, specify types of stationary sources that may obtain general construction permits. A general construction permit may cover numerous similar stationary sources. A general construction permit shall require any stationary source that is covered by the general construction permit to comply with ss. 285.61 to 285.69. The department shall issue a general construction permit using the procedures and criteria in ss. 285.61, 285.63,

285.65, 285.66 and 285.69.

**Explanatory Note:** 

This statutory change will allow the streamlining of certain permits for non-complex stationary sources. Specific rules will describe categories of minor sources that are eligible for general construction permits. Examples could include: crushers, package boilers, degreasing units, dry cleaners and hot-

mix asphalt plants, many of which are small businesses.

Desired Effective Date: Upon passage of the budget.
