Amend s.46.856 to read: "From the appropriation under s.20.435(7)(bg), the department shall award a grant to at least one <u>public or</u> private nonprofit organization, as defined in ..."

Effect of the Change

This change will allow the UW-Madison, School of Medicine or other public organization to receive grant funding for Alzheimer's disease training and information.

Rationale for the Change

Current statutory language allows the Department to contract with a private non-profit organization for Alzheimer's disease training and information. The current grant recipient, the Wisconsin Alzheimer's Institute (WAI), has secured an affiliation with the UW-Madison, School of Medicine. Statutory language needs to be amended to extend eligibility for these grants to public organizations so that the WAI can continue its affiliation with the UW-Madison, School of Medicine.
