Topic: Canteen Operations Revolving Fund

Current Language:

301.27 (2) Vending Stands

(2) Vending Stands. The department shall establish and maintain a revolving fund not exceeding \$60,000 in any of the state institutions administered by the department, for the education, recreation and convenience of patients, inmates and employes, to be used for the operation of vending stands, canteen operations, reading clubs, musical organizations, religious programs, athletics and similar projects. The funds are exempt from s. 20.906, but are subject to audit by the department and the legislative audit bureau in its discretion.

Proposed Language:

301.27 (2) Vending Stands

(2) Vending Stands. The department shall establish and maintain a revolving fund not exceeding ~~\$60,000~~ \$100,000 in any of the state institutions administered by the department, ...in its discretion.

Explanatory Note:

Propose to increase the limit of \$60,000 to \$100,000 in the canteen revolving fund. The current limit is no longer sufficient to meet the operational needs of institutions, particularly those the size of Oshkosh Correctional Institution. Monthly operational expenditures for the canteen range between \$50,000 and \$100,000 depending on the time of the year. Increasing the fund will enable institutions to maintain an adequately stocked canteen and remain in compliance with the statutory limit.

**CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM**

**ADULT CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM**

Under current law, the department of corrections (DOC) must establish and maintain a revolving fund in each of the institutions administered by DOC for the education, recreation and convenience of the patients, inmates and employes of the institutions. The revolving fund is used for the operation of vending stands, canteen operations, reading clubs, musical organizations, religious programs, athletics and similar projects. The revolving fund for each institution may not exceed \$60,000. This bill increases this amount to \$100,000.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 301.27 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4 301.27 (2) VENDING STANDS. The department shall establish and maintain a  
5 revolving fund not exceeding \$60,000 \$100,000 in any of the state institutions

1 administered by the department, for the education, recreation and convenience of  
2 the patients, inmates and employes, to be used for the operation of vending stands,  
3 canteen operations, reading clubs, musical organizations, religious programs,  
4 athletics and similar projects. The funds are exempt from s. 20.906, but are subject  
5 to audit by the department and the legislative audit bureau in its discretion.
