#### **Explanatory Note:**

Propose to increase the limit of \$60,000 to \$100,000 in the canteen revolving fund. The current limit is no longer sufficient to meet the operational needs of institutions, particularly those the size of Oshkosh Correctional Institution. Monthly operational expenditures for the canteen range between \$50,000 and \$100,000 depending on the time of the year. Increasing the fund will enable institutions to maintain an adequately stocked canteen and remain in compliance with the statutory limit.


