Issue/Topic: APPROPRIATION CHANGE - BEAVER CONTROL, FISH & WILDLIFE ACCOUNT

Proposed Change: This request would reduce the continuing balance in the beaver control subsidy appropriation (20.370 (1) (Lr) by \$352,000, and lapse the funding back to the Fish & Wildlife Account of the Conservation Fund.

Explanatory Note: This change is needed to implement a Fish & Wildlife Account spending reduction plan for FY 97 and FY 98 proposed by the Wildlife Management subprogram. Statutory language is required to make the reduction because the appropriation, 20.370 (1)(Lr) is a continuing appropriation, and spending authority not utilized does not automatically lapse back to the Fish & Wildlife Account. This language would need to be in the "Appropriation Changes: natural resources" section of the budget (Section 9237 in the 1997-99 biennial budget). A very similar change was made to appropriation 20.370 (5)(cq) (Recreational Boating Aids) in the 1997-99 biennial budget.

Desired Effective Date: July 1, 1999, or the effective date of the biennial budget.
