16. VEGETABLE PROCUREMENT PRACTICES

EXPLANATION:

The department currently collects, from vegetable contractors, a fee to fund department regulation of processed vegetable procurement practices, including practices related to harvest grading and tare. The department's Bureau of Trade Practices, Dairy and Food Security Section, currently enforces the provisions to which this fee pertains (see s. 100.03, Stats., and ch. ATCP 101, Wis. Adm. Code). The department proposes to deposit the fee to the appropriation account for the Dairy and Food Security Section, to reflect this current responsibility.

STATUTORY LANGUAGE:

SECTION ____ . 20.115(1)(gm) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.115(1)(gm)(title) Dairy and vegetable security and trade practices. The amounts in the schedule for the regulation of vegetable procurement under s. 100.03, of dairy plant financial condition under s. 100.06 and of dairy trade practices under s. 100.201. All moneys received under ss. 100.03(a)2. and 3, 100.06(9) and 100.201(6) shall be credited to this appropriation.

SECTION ____ . 20.115(3)(g) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.115(3)(g) Related services. The amounts in the schedule for the conduct of authorized marketing services, except services financed under par. (h). Except as provided in par. (h), all moneys received from authorized fees related to marketing services, including moneys received for inspection, grading and certification of fruits and vegetables under ss. 93.06(1m), 93.09(1) and 100.03(3)(a)1. and ~~2.~~, shall be credited to this appropriation account.
