INTRODUCTION

This bill is the "executive budget bill" under section 16.47 (1) of the statutes. It contains the governor's recommendations for appropriations from the general fund and from segregated funds for the 1999—100 fiscal biennium.

The bill repeals and recreates the appropriation schedule in chapter 20 of the statutes, thereby setting the appropriation levels for the 1999—A fiscal biennium. The descriptions that follow relate to the most significant changes in the law proposed in the bill. In most cases, changes in the amounts of existing spending authority and changes in the amounts of bonding authority under existing bonding programs are not discussed.

For the fiscal impact of this bill refer to the publication Budget in Brief issued

by the department of administration.

For additional information concerning this bill, see the department of administration's executive budget books, the legislative fiscal bureau's summary document and the legislative reference bureau's drafting files that contain separate drafts on each policy item. In most cases, the policy item drafts contain a more detailed analysis than is printed with this bill.
