PROBLEM

Under current law, a county department of social or human services is required to certify eligibility for and issue food coupons to needy households, except that a Wisconsin Works (W-2) agency is required, to the extent permitted under federal law or waiver, to certify eligibility for and issue food coupons to eligible W-2 participants. The Department has resubmitted the waiver request to the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS), federal Department of Agriculture, to allow W-2 agencies to certify eligibility and issue food coupons for clients eligible for services through the W-2 agency.

PROPOSED CHANGE

See attached LRB draft 0864/4.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These changes will reflect the Department's intent to have individuals, other than those who are aged, blind or disabled, have food stamp eligibility determined and food coupons issued through the W-2 agency. This change is contingent upon receiving approval of the waiver request from FNS.

Under current law, a county department of social or human services is required to certify eligibility for and issue food coupons to needy households, except that a Wisconsin works (W-2) agency is required to certify eligibility for and issue food coupons to eligible participants in the W-2 program.

This bill requires a W-2 agency also to certify eligibility for and issue food coupons to: 1) persons who may be required to participate in the food stamp employment and training program; and 2) other persons who are under the age of 61 and who are not disabled.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
