#### A. RENEWAL FEE CHANGES REQUIRED BY STATUTE

#### **Summary and Justification**

Under sec. 440.03 (9), Stats., each department biennial budget request must include:

- 1. A recalculation of the administrative and enforcement costs of the department that are attributable to the regulation of each occupation or business.
- 2. A recommended change to each of the following fees if the change is necessary to reflect the approximate administrative and enforcement costs of the department that are attributable to the regulation of the particular occupation or business during the biennium:
  - Initial credential fee for which an examination is not required under sec. 440.05 (1), Stats.;
  - Reciprocal credential fee under sec. 440.05 (2), Stats.;
  - Credential renewal fees under sec. 440.08 (2) (a), Stats.
- 3. Changes recommended to credential renewal fees are to reflect an estimate of any additional moneys available for the department's general program operations as a result of appropriation transfers that have been or are estimated to be made under sec. 20.165 (1) (i), Stats. prior to and during that budget period.

#### Proposed Statutory Language

Administrative and enforcement costs, fee calculations and proposed fee schedule revisions are included in the fee study report attached to the budget documents.

Initial applicability of this proposal: September 1, 1999 or the first day of the 2nd month beginning after publication, whichever is later.

#### B. DISCIPLINARY PROCESS ENHANCEMENTS

In 1997-1998 the department created an ad hoc committee of board members and staff charged with developing initiatives to speed and improve the process of investigating and prosecuting complaints. Those recommendations of the Ad Hoc Committee on Enforcement issues requiring statutory changes are included in the requests in this section.

#### **Compliance Inspections**

The department proposes to establish a compliance inspection program. A "compliance inspection" is defined as an inspection conducted by a professional of either (a) his or her licensed location, or (b) specific professional practices, to assure the professional and the department that the location or the practice comply with requirements set by statute and rule.

This proposal to establish a compliance inspection program is patterned after a Pharmacy Examining Board inspection program which has been successfully

#### Introduction

This report explains and demonstrates the results of the Department's 1999-01 fee study and incorporates the Governor's recommendations for fees in his 1999-01 budget bill. This study accompanied the Department's 1999-01 biennial budget request as required under s. 440.03 (9).

440.03 (9) The department shall include all of the following with each biennial budget request that it makes under s. 16.42:

(a) A recalculation of the administrative and enforcement costs of the department that are attributable to the regulation of each occupation or business under chs. 440 to 459 and that are included in the budget request.

(b) A recommended change to each fee specified under s. 440.05 (1) for an initial credential for which an examination is not required.

The Department is funded by revenue from fees charged. Primarily, this revenue is from biennial renewal fees charged to credential holders and from an initial credential fee charged to applicants for credentials. This fee study proposes new fees that will generate the revenue needed for Department operations in the 1999-01 biennium.

### Legislative Audit Bureau Study

In June and July 1992 the Legislative Audit Bureau conducted an audit of the method used by the Department in proposing its 1991-93 renewal fees. In their audit report (#92-20) the LAB states:

We [the LAB] concluded the renewal fee methodology used by the Department was reasonable for two primary reasons. First the methodology appropriately balances the benefits of the Department's centralization of administrative functions with the goal of recovering the costs of specifically identifiable regulatory services from the credential holders who require such services....The second reason we conclude that the methodology was appropriate is that it is relatively straightforward, allowing it to be easily understood and accepted by licensing boards and credential holders, and to be implemented with the existing resources of the Department.

The department's 1991-93,1993-95, 1995-97,1997-99 fee studies and now this 1999-01 fee study use the same methodology as was audited by the LAB.

#### Part I Initial Credential Fee

### The Method Used to Set the Initial Credential Fee

The calculation of the initial credential fee follows these steps.

- 1. Divide the number of new credential holders projected in 1999-01 by the total number of credential holders projected in 1999-01. This sets the percentage that new credential holders are of total credential holders.
- 2. Multiply this percentage times the total administrative costs—including the costs of administering the enforcement function—of the Department. This calculation sets the total amount of the initial credential fees (and is the amount of Department administrative costs that the initial credential fee will recover).
- 3. Divide the total amount of initial credential fees by the number of new credential holders projected in 1999-01. This determines the per-person initial credential fee.

#### The Initial Credential Fee Results

# Step 1 Divide the Number of New Credential Holders by the Number of Total Credential Holders

The "Preliminary Total Administrative Costs" amount does not equal the "Final Total Administrative Costs" amount because the total initial credential fees calculated under Step 2 here will count as "Total Other Revenue". As part of this other revenue, these initial credential fees will reduce the amount of revenue from renewal fees, and thus the "Preliminary Total Administrative Costs" the Department plans to collect.

# Part II Credential Renewal Fees

#### The Method Used to Set Renewal Fees

The Department's fee study follows these steps.

- 1. Determine the revenue the Department will need for its general operations in 1999-01 (including allowing for a 10% FY99 ending balance).
- 2. Determine the revenue that will come from other fees (and not from renewal fees).
- 3. Subtract this revenue (step 2) from the total revenue needed (step 1) to find the revenue that must come from renewal fees.
- 4. From the renewal fee revenue (the results of step 3) subtract the staff costs for the enforcement functions of investigating and prosecuting to determine the administrative cost to be shared by all who will renew their credential in 1999-01.

7

- 5. Determine a base fee for all credential holders by dividing the shared administrative costs (the results of step 4) by the number of credential holders who will renew their credential in 1999-01.
- 6. Using data on the number of closed and open cases in previous years, identify the percentage of time for attorneys, investigators, paralegals and consumer specialists assigned to complaints involving specific credential types.

Three guidelines are used in calculating this data.

- First, the open and closed cases for the physician credential type have been weighted to account for the time and complexity involved in the majority of complaints filed against physicians.
- Secondly, the enforcement component of the fees for certain credential types who have both a very small number of credential holders and have data (in terms of open and closed cases) which has not changed significantly since the last fee study are held constant. These credential types and the number of credential holders include: Cemetery Authority, 72; Cemetery Preneed Seller, 212; Cemetery Salesperson, 257; Barbering and Cosmetology School; 14, Acsthetics School, 2; Electrology School, 2; Manieuring School, 6; and Electrology Instructor, 8.
- Third, in order to account for investigating and prosecuting complaints alleging unlicensed
  practice, the costs for the investigative and prosecutorial activities involving unlicensed
  practitioners (as calculated by total open and total closed cases) have been spread across
  all credential types.

In calculating the enforcement fee, the percentage of open/closed cases is multiplied by the amount of Department enforcement costs which is then divided by the number of credential holders within each credential type. For each credential type, this amount is added to the base fee for all credential holders.

The results of these calculations are shown in the following tables. The formulas used reflect the fact that the Department is appropriated \$0.90 of each \$1.00 in revenue collected.

The table also shows the "% of All Enforcement Costs" assigned to each profession. (This percentage reflects the share of all enforcement costs assigned to the profession after accounting for the differences in attorney, investigator, paralegal, and consumer specialist salaries.) Finally, the column labeled "Enforcement Fee" shows the variable fee each credential holder must pay in addition to the minimum fee.

# Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

#### **OCCUPATIONAL REGULATION**

In its biennial budget request, the department of regulation and licensing (DORL) must recalculate its administrative and enforcement costs attributable to the regulation of each of the occupations and businesses that DORL regulates and, on the basis of these costs, recalculate the fees for initial credentials and for the renewal of credentials already issued. This bill changes the fees for initial and renewal credentials, except for renewal credentials for aesthetics schools, barbering or cosmetology schools, cemetery authorities, cemetery preneed sellers, cemetery salespersons, charitable organizations, electrology instructors, electrology schools and manicuring schools.


In its biennial budget request, the department of regulation and licensing (DORL) must recalculate its administrative and enforcement costs attributable to the regulation of each of the occupations and businesses that DORL regulates and, on the basis of these costs, recalculate the fees for initial credentials and for the renewal of credentials already issued. This bill changes the fees for initial and renewal credentials, except for renewal credentials for aesthetics schools, barbering or cosmetology schools, cemetery authorities, cemetery preneed sellers, cemetery salespersons, charitable organizations, electrology instructors, electrology schools and manicuring schools.
