Draft for 99-01 Budget Bill introduction.

In Section 3989p. 341.14 (6r) (f) 53, change language from "Persons interested in obtaining a plate with the words "Children First" on it to show their support of the prevention of child abuse and neglect" to "Persons interested in obtaining a plate with the words "Celebrate Children" on it to show their support of the prevention of child abuse and neglect."

This language change has been approved by the lead author of the original motion, the Secretary of the Department of Transportation and the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board. This language change more accurately reflects the theme and logo of the philosophy and materials currently in use by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board. The Board wishes to generate additional program revenue by the sale of license plates to augment the funding of child abuse and neglect prevention programs currently funded by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board throughout the State of Wisconsin.

In Section 1733m, referring to s. 48.982 (2) (d), eliminate the last sentence which states: "This paragraph does not apply to moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6."

In Section 1734m, referring to s. 48.982 (2m) (intro.) eliminate the portion of the sentence which states: "except moneys received under s.341.14 (6r) (b) 6."

This language change represents the original intent by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board to generate additional program revenue generated by the sale of license plates for use by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board in continued efforts to expand programming for the prevention of child abuse and neglect in the State of Wisconsin.
