Requested Change

*Safe Drinking Water Loan Program*

Increase state general obligation bonding authority under §20.866(2)(td) by \$3.87 million. The additional amount will bring the state general obligation bonding authority for the safe drinking water loan program to \$16 million.

Currently, under the safe drinking water loan program, this state provides loans to local governmental units for projects for the construction or modification of public water systems. Under current law, the state is authorized to contract public debt in an amount not to exceed \$12,130,000 to fund the safe drinking water loan program. This bill increases that amount to an amount not to exceed \$16,000,000.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 20.866 (2) (td) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 20.866 (2) (td) *Safe drinking water loan program.* From the capital

4 improvement fund, a sum sufficient to be transferred to the environmental

- 1 improvement fund for the safe drinking water loan program under s. 281.61. The
- 2 state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed ~~\$12,130,000~~ \$16,000,000
- 3 for this purpose.

This draft increases the bonding authority for the safe drinking water loan program. Please note that it will be necessary to establish a present value under s. 281.59 (3s) (b) for the amount of the subsidy for the <sup>next</sup> biennium in order for the program to continue to make loans. Present values will also need to be established under s. 281.59 (3e) (b) for the clean water fund program and under s. 281.59 (3m) for the land recycling loan program. (b)
