SECTION 96r. 16.0095 of the statutes is created to read: 16.0095 Medicare upper limit consultant. The department shall hire a consultant, to be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (bm), to determine and recommend to the the [sic] department of health and family services the aggregate payments that should be made for inpatient nursing home services under medical assistance under subch. IV of ch. 49 such that the aggregate payments will not exceed the amount that is estimated to be the amount that would have been paid under the federal medicare program's payment principles. The consultant's recommendations to the department of health and family services shall be nonbinding.

PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

Currently, the federal medicare program provides payment for certain care received by aged, blind or disabled persons who qualify for coverage under the program on the basis of work performed. The federal medical assistance (MA) program is a joint federal-state program that provides payment for medical services received by aged, blind or disabled persons who have very low income and assets. Federal MA laws prohibit states from providing, for care received by MA recipients in nursing homes, payments that, in the aggregate, would exceed the amount that the state estimates would have been paid under payment principles of the federal medicare program that were in effect at the time the care was provided. This limitation is known as the "medicare upper limit" for nursing home payments.

Under current state law, the department of administration (DOA) must hire a consultant to determine and make a nonbinding recommendation to the department of health and family services of the amount of the "medicare upper limit" for nursing home payments under the MA program.

This bill eliminates the requirement that DOA hire a consultant to determine and recommend to DHFS the amount of the "medicare upper limit" for payments to nursing homes under the MA program.
