Please draft the following for the Governor's 1999-01 budget.

Requested change for the Safe Drinking Water Loan Program

- Please change the present value of the loan subsidy in Section 281.59(3s)(b)(1) for the Safe Drinking Water Loan Program from \$21 million to \$5.2 million for the 1999-01 biennium.

Requested change for the Clean Water Fund Program

- Please change the present value of the loan subsidy in Section 281.59(3e)(b)(1) for the Clean Water Fund Program from \$90.2 million to \$87.4 million for the 1999-01 biennium.
