Subject: Drafting Instructions for the 1999-01 Biennial Budget

Please draft the following items for possible inclusion in the Governor's 1999-01 biennial budget bill:

1. Increase the "Low Revenue Ceiling" provision under s. ~~121.905 (1)~~ to \$6,400 in 1999-2000 and \$6,600 in any subsequent year.

2. Create a new separate, annual, categorical aid program (funding source PR-S) under s. 20.255 (2) (effective beginning in 2000-01) for the Alternative school American Indian language and culture education aid program. Also, please "sunset" the current appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ci) as of June 30, 2001.

This item is part of the comprehensive Indian Gaming Initiative (LRB-0757/P2), with funding originating from the PR appropriation account under s. 20.505 (8)(hm).

(Revenues are to be made available from this new appropriation as of October 30th of each year.)

I do not have a figure to insert in the Chapter 20 schedule for this new appropriation at this time.
