This request has two variants:

Variant #1.

Delete 49.45(6v).

The intent here is to end the required transfer from the medical assistance (MA) GPR program benefits appropriation to the COP GPR appropriation. Under this variant, the two appropriations would be delinked and independent.

Variant #2

Amend 49.45(6v) to require that the report under 49.45(6v)(b) includes a discussion and detailed projection of the Medical Assistance GPR and FED program benefits appropriations. This discussion and projection would focus on the likely balances, expenditures, encumbrances and carryover of the two years in the current biennial budget. The transfer language in 49.45(6v)(c) would be amended to limit any transfer to an amount less than is needed to guarantee that the Medical Assistance GPR program benefits appropriation will end the current fiscal year and the biennium with a positive balance (or to lapse money to the general fund). [N.B. Note that this is tricky because the MA appropriation is biennial and therefore a small negative balance in year 1 can be offset by a transfer "back" from year 2 to year 1.]

The intent here is to ensure that the transfer from MA GPR program benefits to the COP GPR appropriation would be limited to an amount that does not incur any meaningful risk of causing the expenditures of the MA GPR appropriation to exceed the amounts budgeted in that appropriation.

Of these two variants, #2 is the most likely to go forward.

Currently, the department of health and family services (DHFS) must annually submit to the joint committee on finance of the legislature (JCF) a report on nursing home bed utilization by medical assistance (MA) recipients for the previous year. If the report indicates that the utilization, has decreased, DHFS must include a proposal to transfer funds from the MA general purpose revenues appropriation account to the community options program appropriation account for expenditure for 'noninstitutional long-term support services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 49.45 (6v) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

49.45 (6v) (b) The department shall, each year, submit to the joint committee on finance a report for the previous fiscal year, except for the 1997-98 fiscal year, that provides information on the utilization of beds by recipients of medical assistance in facilities and a discussion and detailed projection of the likely balances, expenditures, encumbrances and carryover of currently appropriated amounts in the appropriation accounts under s. 20.435 (5) (b) and (o).

49.45 (6v) (c) If the report specified in par. (b) indicates that utilization of beds by recipients of medical assistance in facilities decreased, the department shall include a proposal to transfer moneys from the appropriation under s. 20.435 (5) (b) to the appropriation under s. 20.435 (7) (bd) for the purpose of increasing funding for the community options program under s. 46.27. The amount proposed for transfer may not reduce the balance in the appropriation account under s. 20.435(5)(b) below an amount necessary to ensure that that appropriation account will end the current fiscal year or the current fiscal biennium with a positive balance. The secretary shall transfer the amount identified under the proposal.

- 1. To deal with the problem of a small negative balance in year 1, please note that in s. 49.45 (6v) (c), stats., I used "or" instead of "and". Okay?
- 2. Do you wish to retain the language requiring the secretary to transfer the amount included in the proposal? If this is retained, it would appear that the proposed amendments are unnecessary, because DHFS has the authority both to establish the amount in the proposal and to transfer that amount. Do you want the joint finance committee to first approve the amount proposed to be transferred?
