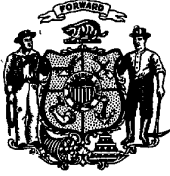
Subject: Statutory Language Changes

Please draft legislation for the budget that would allow for the following:

1. Require the Department of Transportation (DOT) to review its rule making process pertaining to a dealer processing fee allowance. The allowance would allow a motor vehicle dealer, at its option, to charge a fee relating to a vehicle purchase for functions the dealer must perform prior to the vehicle's delivery. *(High priority)* -1157
2. Change the tax reporting date for motor fuel tax collection from the end of the month to the 20th of the month and change the tax payment date from the 15th of the month to the 20th. *(Low priority)* -1158
3. Require terminal suppliers to collect "destination state" motor fuel taxes prior to shipment from Wisconsin terminals to out-of-state destinations. *(Low priority)* -1160
4. Change s. 13.48(13) to exempt the state's public safety communication radio towers from local zoning requirements. *(High priority)* -1161
5. Create an earmark in the Transportation Enhancements appropriation to allow funding for the "Bong Air Museum" in Superior, WI. Require a 10 percent local match for the appropriated funds. *(High priority)* 21.315(2) (nx) -1162

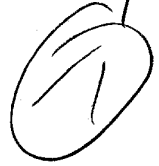
