Please draft for inclusion in the Governor's 1999-2001 budget bill language that will give the Department of Financial Institutions the ability to establish and assess fees to access and otherwise use departmental computer systems. It appears the most reasonable place for this language would be in s. 224.30(3), Wisconsin Statutes.

The purpose of this amendment to statutes is to allow DFI to charge "private" customers a fee for data that will be available electronically. While DFI will not likely charge governmental agencies for electronic data, the Department would like to be able to establish and assess a fee to help recapture the costs of providing the data electronically for public access. DFI was wondering if LRB draft 1191/1 could be changed to allow DFI to charge state and local agencies for these services (I had incorrectly assumed their intent). Why don't we take out the language prohibiting DFI from charging the fee to state and local agencies, at least for now.

DFI also wanted to include something that allows them to charge a small premium if a request is for a special service that DFI doesn't routinely provide. DFI suggested this change to line 17:

"recapture the costs of providing the access or use to the public, unless the product or service is in a form created solely for the purpose of sale.
