Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR), in conjunction with the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection (DATCP), the land and water conservation board (LWCB) and local governmental units, administers a program to provide financial assistance for measures to reduce water pollution from nonpoint (diffuse) sources. Under current law, the nonpoint source program is funded with general purpose state revenues, segregated revenues from the environmental fund and proceeds of state bonds. This bill provides funds for the nonpoint program from moneys paid to the state under Indian gaming compacts.


