Create a new annual appropriation in s. 20.505(1) from the moneys received under s. 59.72(5)(a) to fund the development of a computer-based land information system.

Modify s. 20.505(1)(ij) to include the new appropriation in the language "all moneys not appropriated under par. (ie)..."

Currently, the land information board directs and supervises the land information program. The board is abolished effective September 1, 2003. Prior to September 1, 2003, counties must transfer to the land information board a portion of the fees collected by registers of deeds for recording documents. Revenues from these fees support the operation of the board and the remainder are used to provide grants to counties for land records modernization projects.

Currently, the department of administration (DOA) is authorized to develop and maintain a geographic information system relating to land in this state for the use of governmental and nongovernmental units. Currently, the land information board directs and supervises the land information program. The board is abolished effective September 1, 2003. Prior to September 1, 2003, counties must transfer to the land information board a portion of the fees collected by registers of deeds for recording documents. Revenue from these fees supports the operation of the board and the remainder is used to provide grants to counties for land records modernization projects.

This bill directs the land information board to transfer a portion of this fee revenue, prior to September 1, 2003, to DOA for the purpose of developing and maintaining a computer-based Wisconsin land information system, without direction or supervision from the board. Under the bill, DOA continues to be responsible for the development and maintenance of the system on and after September 1, 2003, but the bill provides no specific funding for this purpose.

The bill also authorizes DOA to conduct soil surveys and soil mapping activities. Under the bill, DOA may assess any state agency any amount that it

determines to be required to conduct the surveys and mapping activities. In addition, the bill permits DOA to contract with the board of commissioners of public lands to conduct soil surveys and soil mapping activities on lands under the jurisdiction of that board. The bill appropriates to DOA all revenue received from state agencies to be used for soil surveys and soil mapping activities.

Currently, the land information board directs and supervises the land information program. The board is abolished effective September 1, 2003. Prior to September 1, 2003, counties must transfer to the land information board a portion of the fees collected by registers of deeds for recording documents. Revenue from these fees supports the operation of the board and the remainder is used to provide grants to counties for land records modernization projects.

This bill directs the land information board to transfer a portion of this fee revenue, prior to September 1, 2003, to DOA for the purpose of developing and maintaining a computer-based Wisconsin land information system, without direction or supervision from the board. Under the bill, DOA continues to be responsible for the development and maintenance of the system on and after September 1, 2003, but the bill provides no specific funding for this purpose.

The bill also authorizes DOA to conduct soil surveys and soil mapping activities. Under the bill, DOA may assess any state agency any amount that it

determines to be required to conduct the surveys and mapping activities. In addition, the bill permits DOA to contract with the board of commissioners of public lands to conduct soil surveys and soil mapping activities on lands under the jurisdiction of that board.
