In the 1997-99 budget, \$50,000 annually was allocated from the WDF to a nonprofit organization that provides assistance to organizations and individuals in urban areas (Reggie White's Urban Hope) under s. 560.06. The funding was to be provided in fiscal years 1997-98, 1998-99 and 1999-00. We would like to change the funding for fiscal year 1999-00 to \$100,000 and allow it to come from either the WDF GPR appropriation (20.143 (1) (c) or the WDF repayments appropriation 20.143 (1) (ie). Currently, the funding comes only from (1) (c). We do not wish to change the MOU requirement, presumably DOA and Commerce could modify the current MOU if needed.
