Subject: Indian Gaming Initiative Drafting Request

The Wisconsin Arts Board (WAB) and the State Historical Society (SHS) are expected to receive funding through the Indian Gaming Initiative (IGI). Language is needed to establish PR-S appropriations in these agencies for IGI funds.

In the WAB, the IGI funds will be new authority and will not fund any positions. The SHS funding, on the other hand, will replace GPR funding for the Northern Great Lakes Center. Funding for the Northern Great Lakes Center is currently being made from the appropriation under s.20.245(1)(a) and funds three positions.

In the Arts Board's biennial budget request, the agency asked for \$25,200 in s.20.215(1)(b). DOA's recommendation is to grant WAB an increase of \$25,200 but in a new PR-S appropriation using indian gaming funds. As a result, I feel that the language describing the new appropriation should be similar to the language of s.20.215(1)(a), but modified to specify that only Native American groups, individuals, organizations and institutions are eligible for these funds. The WAB has established rules and procedures to determine the recipients of state aid for the arts which should be able to be applied to this new program with minimal or no alteration.
