DRAFTING INSTRUCTIONS

STATE AND COUNTY CONSULTATION ON CHILD WELFARE CONTRIBUTION

Background

Under current law (s. 48.561(3)(b)) the Secretary of the Department of Administration (DOA) must consult with Milwaukee County to determine the method by which the state will collect the amount of funds the county owes the state for child welfare services. If Milwaukee County and DOA do not agree, by September 15 of each year, DOA shall determine the method without the agreement of the county.

DOA and Milwaukee County have agreed, that beginning in CY99, a portion of the contribution will come from shared revenue (\$20.1M) and the remainder will come from the county's Community Aids allocation.

Requested Change

Amend s. 48.561(3)(b) to:

1. Remove the requirement that DOA and Milwaukee County consult to determine the method by which the state will collect Milwaukee's contribution; and
2. Add Community Aids (s. 46.40) to the list of state payments from which the county's contribution can be taken.

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

CHILDREN

Under current law, the department of health and family services (DHFS) must provide child welfare services in a county having a population of 500,000 or more and that county must contribute moneys in each state fiscal year for the provision of those services by DHFS. Currently, the department of administration (DOA) and the county must consult to determine the method by which the state will collect those moneys. If DOA and the county reach an agreement as to that method and if that agreement calls for deducting all or part of those moneys from any state shared revenue payments due the county or for adding a special charge to the amount of property taxes apportioned to and levied on the county, DOA must notify the department of revenue, by September 15 of each year, of the amount to be deducted or added as a special charge. If DOA and the county do not reach an agreement, DOA must determine the method of collecting the moneys without the agreement of the county. This bill eliminates the requirement that DOA and the county agree as to the method by which the state will collect those moneys and provides instead that DOA may collect those moneys by deducting all or part of those moneys from any community aids ~~moneys~~ or shared revenue payments due the county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 48.561 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

The department of administration shall ^u credit all amounts collected under this paragraph to the appropriation account under s. 20.435 (3) (kw) and shall notify the county from which those amounts are collected of that collection.
