DRAFTING INSTRUCTIONS

INSTITUTIONS FOR MENTAL DISEASE

Background

The Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) provides a supplemental payment to Medicaid certified nursing facilities for residents with mental illness who require specialized services. The payments are funded entirely with GPR and are budgeted in the Medical Assistance's GPR appropriation.

Federal law prohibits any Medical Assistance (MA) reimbursement to an institution for mental diseases (IMD) for any resident who is between the ages of 18 and 64. However, federal law requires that any resident who is determined to need services through a Preadmission Screening and Resident Review receive the services. DHFS has provided funding for the specialized services at a rate of \$9.00 per day. Three facilities have been receiving reimbursement for the cost of the specialized services.

In May of 1998 federal nursing home regulators cited the Trempealeau County Health Care Center for use of physical restraints and seclusion of residents. Trempealeau County voluntarily surrendered its federal Medicaid certification and relocated its MA funded residents (age 65 and older). As of September 1, 1998 the facility became a state-only licensed nursing home with 76 beds. Through a s. 13.10, funds were transferred from 20.435(5)(a) to s. 20.435(7)(be) to allow DHFS to continue reimbursing the facility for the specialized services.

Requested Change

Amend s. 46.266(1) to allow funds under appropriation s. 20.435(7)(be) to be used for active treatment for mental illness for residents that require services under s. 49.45(6c)(b).

MENTAL ILLNESS AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

Under current law, the department of health and family services (DHFS) provides, from general purpose revenues, funding through county departments of community programs for mental health treatment services for persons who are in or relocated from facilities that have been found by the federal health care financing administration to be institutions for mental diseases (and, thus, ineligible for receipt of medical assistance (MA)). Also under current law, every person who applies for admission to a nursing home or to an institution for mental diseases must be screened to determine if the person has a developmental disability or mental illness and, if so, whether the person needs facility care and active treatment for the developmental disability or mental illness.

This bill requires DHFS to provide funding from general purpose revenues, as a part of mental health treatment services for persons in or relocated from institutions for mental diseases, for active treatment for mental illness for a person who has been determined, through screening, to have mental illness and to need the
