PROGRAMS FOR ADOLESCENTS AND ADOLESCENT PARENTS

Background

The adolescent self-sufficiency and pregnancy prevention program under s. 46.995, the adolescent services program under s. 46.996 and adolescent choices project grants under s. 46.997 are currently funded with general program revenues under the appropriation s. 20.435(3)(eg).

Requested Change

Fund the programs in part or entirely with federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds from the Department of Workforce Development as follows:

1. Amend s. 46.995(2) to change the appropriation from s. 20.435(3)(eg) to s. 20.435(3)(ky).
2. Amend s.46.996 to add the appropriation under s. 20.435(3)(ky).
3. Amend s. 46.997(2) to change the appropriation from s. 20.435(3)(eg) to s. 20.435(3)(ky).

This bill decreases general purpose revenues and provides program revenue-service moneys that are transferred from the department of workforce development (DWD) to the department of health and family services (DHFS), in the amount of that decrease, fund adolescent choices project grants.
