Requested Change

Amend s. 46.84 to create a new woman's AODA treatment program as follows:

- 1. From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (7)(md), the department may award not more than \$1,167,900 in each fiscal year as grants to counties or private organizations to implement substance abuse treatment programs that meet the special needs of women with substance abuse problems.
- 2. Require that the grants be awarded in accordance with the department's request for proposal procedures.
- 3. Require the department to ensure that the grants are distributed in both urban and rural communities.
- 4. The grant monies are to be used to establish community-based women's programs that emphasize community coordination, intensive care coordination, parent education, vocational and housing assistance.
- 5 Require the department to develop client outcome measurements that are to be used to evaluate the programs.
