**CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM**

**JUVENILE CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM**

Under current law, general purpose revenues (GPR) are appropriated annually to the department of corrections (DOC) for juvenile program services for serious juvenile offenders, juvenile correctional services for juveniles who are under the extended jurisdiction of the court assigned to exercise jurisdiction under the juvenile justice code (juvenile court) and juvenile correctional services for juveniles who have been sentenced to the Wisconsin state prisons. This bill changes that GPR annual appropriation to a GPR biennial appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 20.410 (3) (cg) of the statutes is amended to read:  
3 20.410 (3) (cg) *Serious juvenile offenders.* The Biennially, the amounts in the  
4 schedule for juvenile correctional institution, corrective sanctions, alternate care,

1     aftercare and other juvenile program services specified in s. 938.538 (3) provided for  
2     the persons specified in s. 301.26 (4) (cm), for juvenile correctional institution  
3     services for persons placed in juvenile correctional institutions under s. 973.013 (3m)  
4     and for juvenile correctional services for persons under 18 years of age placed with  
5     the department under s. 48.366 (8). Notwithstanding s. 20.001 (3) ~~(a)~~ (b), the  
6     unencumbered balance of this appropriation ~~account~~ on June 30 of each the 2nd  
7     fiscal year of each fiscal biennium is transferred to the appropriation account under  
8     par. (cd).
