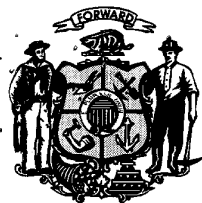

Please draft an additional statutory language change to create a statutory reference to fund a tribal services coordinator and grants request from the Department of Veterans Affairs, using gaming compact funding from s. 20.505 (8)(hm). This is a new position and no appropriation appears to be available under Program 2: Loans and Aids to Veterans. This is part of the Indian Gaming Initiative, which should be noted for your tracking purposes. Please draft this statutory change as follows:

"The amounts in the schedule for Tribal Services Coordinator and Grants under s.(reference). All moneys transferred from the appropriation under s. 20.505 (8)(hm) (sub xxx) shall be credited to this appropriation account [The sub xxx will refer to your program's reference under (8)(hm).]

The grants will go to tribal governments to create a model to overcome barriers to Native American veterans receiving state and federal veterans benefits. \$15,000 would go for grants in FY00, \$10,000 in FY01. The other part of the request is for 1.0 FTE Tribal Services Coordinator, or \$51,900 in FY00, and \$58,000 in FY01, which we are approving as a four-year project position. This position will serve as a liaison between the department and the tribes to increase veterans services to these veterans. The Department of Veterans Affairs will give the grants to the Native American tribes, though it is not known how many grants will be issued.

What needs to happen is to give DVA the authority for this position and the grants as a separate appropriation in Chapter 20. I forwarded the instruction passed to all of the LRB attorneys earlier to you that details how this needs to be drafted. If you have any other questions, please let me know. Thanks.
