Currently, the individual remains eligible until the W–2 group's assets exceed the asset limit for at least two months or until the W–2 group's income is *expected* to exceed the income limit for at least two consecutive months.

Under this bill, an individual remains eligible for W-2 until the W-2 group's assets are *expected* to exceed the asset limit for at least two consecutive months, as is currently the case with respect to the W-2 group's income.
