Please draft the following item for enclosure in the 1999-01 budget bill:

Community Based Hunger Prevention Program Grants

Under s. 46.765(4) the community based hunger prevention program grants may not be awarded after June 30, 1999.

The request is to repeal s. 20.435(3)(dr), community based hunger prevention program grants. This will facilitate a clean removal of \$250,000 GPR in FY00 and FY01 from the Department of Health and Family Services' (DHFS) GPR base.

I am not requesting the repeal of s. 46.765 since s. 46.765(4) also requires DHFS to submit a report, by June 30, 2000, on the grants and hunger prevention activities. I am assuming that DHFS can have this provision repealed under remedial legislation once the report has been submitted.
