Imposition of the special weight limitations authorized by sub. (1) (b) shall be done by erecting signs before each end of the bridge or culvert to which the weight limitation applies sufficient to give reasonable notice that a special weight limitation is in effect and the nature of that limitation. All weight limitation signs and their erection shall comply with the rules of the department and shall be standard throughout the state.

This draft may require "advance warning signs" at *every* intersection along an affected highway, since this draft essentially requires notice to every motorist entering the highway. I am not aware of any legal cases involving required signing under s. 349.16 (2), stats., and cannot predict with certainty how a court would interpret this new requirement. Because of the number of signs that will likely be required by this draft, I have delayed the imposition of the requirement until July 1, 2000. OK?

Another approach (to avoid so many signs) would be to require a turn—around spot immediately before the affected highway, although this may not be feasible on many highways and may be just as expensive as signs.
