Well, I've been talking to DVR quite a bit lately regarding statutory language for Indian Gaming funds in DVR. I think you only need to create a PR-S appropriation for this purpose. Something like,

20.445(5)(kg) -- ~~the amounts in the schedule for the purchase of~~ goods and services authorized under chapter 47, and for the purchase of vocational rehabilitation programs for native american individuals or organizations.
