Subject: FY 1999-2001 Budget Statutory Language Proposal – Indian Gaming Initiative

The following is an additional statutory language proposal for the FY1999-2001 biennial budget. I have indicated my priority ranking below.

The intent of this request is to create a new appropriation to be funded by revenues from the Indian gaming compacts. This item would need to be included in the Indian gaming revenue appropriation – 20.505(8)(hm).

Similar to s. 20.370(3)(aq), the PR-S appropriation would provide funds for snowmobile enforcement operations and ss. 350.055, 350.12(4)(a)2m., 3. and 3m. and 350.155 for safety training and fatality reporting.
