

RECREATION

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) may expend amounts appropriated from the conservation fund for the purpose of snowmobile enforcement operations and for safety training and fatality reporting. This bill creates a program revenue—service appropriation from the general fund that is funded by certain moneys received by the state pursuant to Indian gaming compacts. The bill permits DNR to also expend amounts from this program revenue—service appropriation for these snowmobile enforcement and safety purposes.
