ADULT CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM

Under current law, the department of corrections (DOC), until July 1, 1999, may operate the juvenile secured correctional facility at Prairie du Chien as a state prison for nonviolent offenders under 21 years of age. This bill permits DOC to operate that facility as a state prison for female prisoners.

Please note the following two points about this draft:

- 1. That the draft resembles LRB-1395/3 insofar as the draft renumbers to the statutes the nonstatutory provision authorizing DOC to operate the Prairie du Chien facility as a correctional facility for young adults. This is necessary because the extension of that authority by this draft extends that authority past July 1 of the even-numbered year of the biennium after the biennium in which the nonstatutory provision was created.
