Would you please draft language for inclusion in the budget bill that creates a separate tuition appropriation for UW Madison. The new appropriation would be continuing and all monies received from academic student fees paid by students attending UW-Madison would be credited to it.

I believe we should not have to change appropriations 20.285 (1) (Lm) and 20.285 (1) (Ls). Under current law, the amounts in the schedule are transferred to these appropriations from 20.285 (1) (im). I am assuming that if we create an additional tuition appropriation, the funds in (Lm) and (Ls) could be transferred from both "academic student fee" appropriations. UW officials could decide how much funding would be transferred from each of the tuition appropriations.
