UW officials could decide how much funding would be transferred from each of the tuition appropriations.

Under current law, degree credit instruction sponsored by the University of Wisconsin System (UW System), other than credit outreach instruction sponsored by the University of Wisconsin–Extension, is funded from an appropriation consisting of all academic student fees received by the UW System. This bill creates a separate appropriation, consisting of all academic student fees received by the University of Wisconsin–Madison (UW–Madison), to fund degree credit instruction sponsored by UW–Madison.



#### **HIGHER EDUCATION**

Under current law, all academic student fees received by the board of regents (board) of the University of Wisconsin System (UW System) are credited to an appropriation account that funds degree credit instruction for the UW System. However, the board may, with some exceptions, spend only the amounts in the appropriation schedule for degree credit instruction. This bill, with some exceptions, authorizes the board to spend all academic student fee revenue it receives for degree credit instruction.
