DER needs to be able to receive TANF funds. I don't think their existing appropriations would allow this. Therefore, we need something like what I requested for the Governor's Office yesterday -- see message below. We need the same thing for agency 512. Sorry about the confusion here, but we thought an existing budget draft would be adequate to cover this.

Could you please have drafted as an item for the budget a new PRS appropriation in Office of the Governor for the funding of projects and purposes agreed to between the Governor and other state agencies? It could be modeled after the current law s.20.292(1)(b) Interagency projects; state operations. The amounts in the schedule to be expended for state operations in conformity with the purposes and requirements agreed to by the Governor. All money received from state agencies for state operations shall be credited to this appropriation.

The goal here is to have a means for funding the costs of projects in Office of the Governor which are undertaken in the Office and which involve the programs and policies of other state agencies. For example, we intend to request in this appropriation a position to assist the Governor in rail transportation policies the costs of which will be billed to the Department of Transportation by mutual agreement.
