It could be modeled after the current law s.20.292(1)(kb) Interagency projects; state operations. The amounts in the schedule to be expended for state operations in conformity with the purposes and requirements agreed to by the Governor. All money received from state agencies for state operations shall be credited to this appropriation.

The goal here is to have a means for funding the costs of projects in Office of the Governor which are undertaken in the Office and which involve the programs and policies of other state agencies. For example, we intend to request in this appropriation a position to assist the Governor in rail transportation policies the costs of which will be billed to the Department of Transportation by mutual agreement.
